This weeks discussion guide:

Welcome to our final week of our Spring small group season! We have been praying with and for you over the past 6 weeks that you have drawn near to God and each other as you have studied His Word together. There are many things happening this summer, and we encourage you to be involved in those events. - In the video, Pete said, "Jesus made it possible for our sins to be removed because his blood was spotless; He was a perfect sacrifice for us." How could Jesus be perfect? What are the implications of that?

- How have you developed your personal relationship with God?

- Matthew 7:7 says that if we seek, we will find; if we knock, the door will be opened. What might this mean for us?

- How can we help other people grow in their personal relationships with God? Is it our job to do this?

Further Discussion:

Read the following passage Jeremiah 31:33-34

How does the reference to "write it on their hearts" in verse 33 contribute to our understanding of a close relationship with God?

How does the possessive reference to "their God" and "my people" contribute to our understanding of a close relationship with God?

From verse 34 we see that God desires first-hand knowledge of Him rather than second-hand. What is second-hand knowledge of God?

What hinders you from deepening your relationship with God?

How does an intimate relationship with God bring joy to the soul? How have you seen this lived out in your own life?

Why does God desire to know us personally?

If you believe the Bible is from God, what lead you to this conviction?
