The Message of the Book of Revelation:

"Write therefore the things that you have seen, those that are and those that are to take place after this." Revelation 1:19 (ESV)

The Method of the Book of Revelation:

Three early examples in Rev. 1:

"7-fold Spirit"	Rev. 1:4-5	refers to the Holy Spirit	(Isaiah 11:2)
"7 Lampstands"	Rev. 1:12	refers to the 7 churches	(Revelation 1:20)
"7 Stars"	Rev 1:16	refers to the 7 pastors	(Malachi 2:6-7)

"To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: 'The words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the seven golden lampstands. 2 "I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance, and how you cannot bear with those who are evil, but have tested those who call themselves apostles and are not, and found them to be false. 3 I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary.

Revelation 2:1-3 (ESV)

Three Encouragements: (Rev. 2:2)

- toil: "Labor to the point of exhaustion"
- patient endurance: "a courageous acceptance of hardship, suffering and loss"
- · discernment: "a sensitivity to God's truth and a refusal to be swayed by false teaching"

One Main Concern:

But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love Revelation 2:4 (ESV) you had at first.

Three Keys To Rekindle the Fire:

Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. Revelation 2:5a (ESV)
